School Uniform Policy

Our goal with these guidelines is to ensure that uniforms are neat and fit appropriately.
The Holy Rosary Uniform Policy goes through the School Administration and School Commission.
The Purpose of the Uniform Policy is to free students of distractions from their learning.
Teachers will enforce the Uniform Policy.

Shirts and Blouses	Shirts need to be long enough to be tucked in appropriately.		
	White Collared Blouse or Polo Shirt	Pre-K – Grade 5	Both boys and girls
	Navy or White Collared Polo Shirt	Grade 6- Grade 8	Both boys and girls
Holy Rosary Emblem Sweatshirt	Crew neck sweatshirt with Holy Rosary Emblem	Pre K – Grade 8	Both boys and girls
Holy Rosary Outer-Wear	Fleece vests, hooded sweatshirts	Pre-K-Grade 8	These articles of clothing are considered appropriate for wear only outside.
Pants	Waistbands of pants, shorts, skorts, and skirts must be worn no lower than at the natural waist.		
	Navy Cords or slacks	Pre-K – Grade 5	Both boys and girls.
	Khaki Slacks	Grade 6 - Grade 8	Both boys and girls
Jumpers, Skirts, Skorts, Shorts	Skirts, jumpers, skorts and shorts should be no more than 3 inches above the knee.		
	Uniform Plaid Jumper or Skort	Pre-K – Grade 5	Girls
	Uniform Plaid Skirts or Skort	Grade 6 - Grade 8	Girls
	Navy Skorts	Pre-K – Grade 5	Girls
	Khaki or Navy Skorts	Grade 6 - Grade 8	Girls
	Navy Shorts	Pre-K – Grade 8	Both boys and girls
	Khaki Shorts	Pre-K – Grade 8	Both boys and girls

Socks	For safety and sanitary reasons, all students must wear socks. Socks must be visible and cover the feet. Only the solid colors of red, white and navy are allowed. Students at Holy Rosary are allowed to wear red, white, or navy tights. Leggings are not appropriate for school.		
Shoes	Everyday Shoes	All Students	All shoes worn to school must be non-marking in good condition, securely fastened, and appropriate for play and school.
	P.E. Shoes	All Students	Must be athletic shoes that tie securely.
	Boots	All Students	Boots may be worn to school only when there is snow on the ground. Students will change into school shoes when they are in the classroom.
	Uggs, Sandals, beachwear, and open-toe shoes are not allowed at school.		
Hats	Hats may be worn before and after school, or when students are outside to keep their heads warm.		
Hair	Students may not change the natural color of their hair. Hair should be groomed away from the face so that students can see and be seen. Bangs must be trimmed above the eyebrows for both boys and girls.		
	Hair clips/accessories	All Girls	Hair accessories must be conservative and of solid colors or school plaid.
	Boys' Hair	All Boys	Boys' hair must not extend over the ears or eyebrows, or extend below the top of the shirt collar.
	Facial Hair	All Boys	Students at Holy Rosary are expected to be neat and clean shaven.
Jewelry	For safety reasons the only jewelry permitted in the science room or gym are post earrings. Body piercings, and visible tattoos are not permitted.		
	Earrings	All Girls	Girls may wear only small post earrings.
		Boys are not permitted to wear earrings	
	Necklaces	All Grades	Only small necklaces are allowed
	Bracelets	All Grades	Large, distracting bracelets are not permitted
Make-Up and Nail Polish	Make-up must look natural. No make-up, including lip gloss may be applied during class times. Only clear nail polish is permitted. Students should not have artificial fingernails.		

Formal Uniform –

The formal uniform is the attire we expect of students on days when we celebrate Mass as a school.

	Proper sized clean and tidy pants or shorts – Boys and Girls
	Proper sized clean and tidy skirts or skorts – Girls only

Free Dress Days	
All Students	All messages or logos on clothing must present a positive image, acceptable to the Catholic community.
	All clothing worn to school must be appropriately sized, neither too tight nor sagging, and should be neat, clean and in good repair.
	Shoe requirements do not change on free dress days.
