The children are enjoying new friendships and making good choices during Free Choice and at recess with them. Our in-house field trip today "Worms on Wheels" was fabulous. The Children learned the different parts of a worm, what kinds of food they eat and why worms are important in our world. Ask your child what else they found in the dirt the worms were crawling in.

Religion - our lesson was "God Made Friends" - we discussed how important friends are and how we can show kindness to them.

Literacy/Reading - we learned the letters L,E,F using HWT tools for formation. The children learned the words (meet, shake) - they practiced with one another saying - "My name is _____ it's nice to meet you and shake their hands.

Math - we practiced identifying shapes and drawing them. The children created colors using droppers filled with different paint colors by mixing them together on paper towel leaves - (these will come home next week). Children identified the word of a color and matched it with a crayon/marker. We practiced counting and identifying the number "5" (five).
