Dear Families,

A huge thank you goes to all our students, parents and staff for the tremendous outpouring of support and participation for the Ram Run, sponsored by the fabulous Parent Association. It was a very well-orchestrated and well-organized event, resulting in \$17,300 being raised. Way to go Rams! I would especially like to thank this year's organizing committee: Beth Mitchell, Jolee Cano, and Jessica Foy. Also kudos go to all the volunteers working this fabulous event – we couldn't have done it without your help!

Since Halloween is on a weekday (Tuesday) this year, we will be having the costume parade at school for all students grades PK-8 on Halloween Day. Students may wear their costumes to school that day. Just a reminder: we do not allow any violent (no weapons) or gruesome costumes. The start time for this parade will be 8:45 AM, and all parents are welcome to come and watch the parade of students and staff. The parade route will take us around to each classroom, through the parish offices and pastoral center, and end up in the gym. The parade of students will then form a large circle around the perimeter of the gym which will provide a perfect photo opportunity for the parents, who will be in the center of the circle.

At this mass our 4th graders will be portraying their special saints in celebration of this feast day. 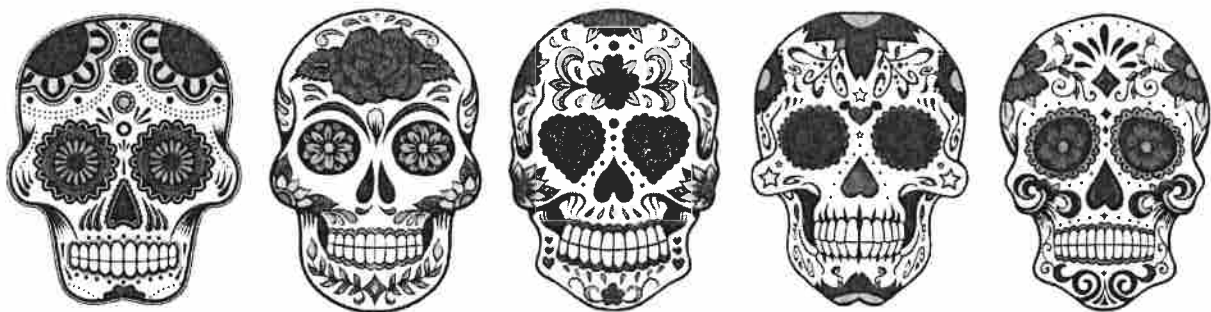

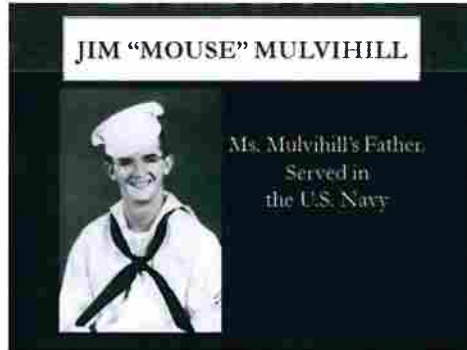

Please remember to include the name of the Veteran, The Branch of Service the Veteran served with, and the name of the children or staff members the Veteran is related to.

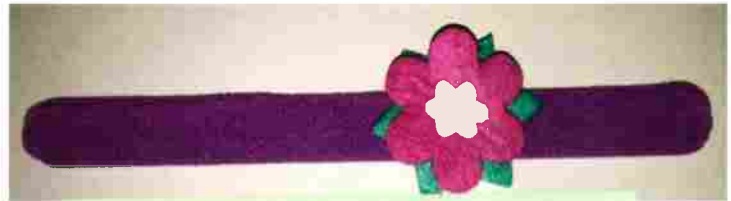
