Dear Families,

If you happened to walk into our school office during the last few days you would have seen a huge collection of warm coats, a product of the generosity of our Holy Rosary School families. Mrs. Bilanko and her first grade students did an outstanding job of organizing, publicizing and collecting 100 coats for the migrant children in Burlington. This has been an excellent service project for our first graders in learning the importance of giving to others in need.

Since Halloween is on a weekday (Monday) this year, we will be having the costume parade at school for all students grades PK-8 on Halloween Day. Students may wear their costumes to school that day. Just a reminder: we do not allow any violent (no weapons) or gruesome costumes. The parade will start at 8:45 AM. The parade route will take us around to each classroom, through the parish offices and pastoral center, and end up in the gym.
