Dear Parents,

Tonight is our Parent Association general meeting at 7:00PM in the Pastoral Center. All parents are encouraged to attend. Refreshments will be served. Please join us and learn what your Parent Association has accomplished this year and plans for next year.

Following is a reprint of the email sent yesterday regarding Father Petosa. We want to ensure all families have this information.

It is with great sadness that I inform you of the passing of Father Joe Petosa last Friday morning. He was truly an amazing priest and much loved by all. A rosary will be held for him on Sunday, May 14<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 PM at Our Lady of Perpetual Help in Everett. The funeral will be here at Holy Rosary Church on Monday, May 15<sup>th</sup> at 11:00 AM. All are welcome to attend these services. Archbishop Sartain will preside at the funeral, accompanied by 40-50 priests.

Since Father Petosa had been at several parishes throughout his 62 years of priesthood we anticipate that his funeral will be attended by a large number of people. The church will be overflowing, so we will open the gym for seating and communion as we provide a live feed of the service in the church. The school cafeteria will be used as a secondary reception area since the Pastoral Center can only accommodate 300-400 hundred people.

Parking lots will be completely full as will the surrounding streets. Guests will begin arriving around 9:30 and continue throughout the morning. We are concerned about our students' safety that day with this very large crowd on campus for the majority of the day. <u>Due to these extraordinary circumstances, we will not have school on Monday, May 15<sup>th</sup></u>. Honor Choir and Band are also cancelled for Monday.

Thank you for your understanding in light of this special occasion. Father Petosa will be sorely missed, and we are pleased that we can honor him with a loving celebration of his life on May  $15^{th}$ .

- A few dollars to purchase snacks. All money should be placed in a plastic bag with the students name on it.


**Lunch:** No hot lunch for grades 1-3. Lunch will be eaten at school before they leave for the track meet at 10:45 AM.

Pick Up: Students will return to school for regular pick up.


