## PRIMARY TRACK MEET: IMPORTANT INFORMATION

PRIMARY TRACK MEET-FRIDAY, MAY 19<sup>th</sup> AT ST. MARY MAGDALEN SCHOOL IN EVERETT FROM 11:30AM-2:00PM

Participants need to be at the field by 11:30. Students they should leave school around 10:45. Holy Rosary students should wear their blue Holy Rosary Spirit T-shirts to the meet. A blue t-shirt will be all right if your child doesn't have a spirit shirt. Students should bring water bottles and sunscreen and be prepared with raingear. A concession stand will be at the event. If your student would like to purchase concessions, please provide them with small bills in a ziplock bag with the student's name on it. The bag will be given to the student's teacher at the beginning of the day. Some classes will eat lunch prior to leaving school, check with your child's classroom teacher to determine when they will eat lunch. Your student may need to have a snack as well.

The Holy Rosary spectator area is the southeast area. No parents are allowed at the starting line, finish line, or judges table. Only volunteers and the students in the event are allowed at the starting line and finish line. If you have any concerns please bring them to Sr. Kath or the other coaches. Do not bring concerns to volunteers.

The students will be wearing name tags with their events and the time of their events. Students should get in line for their event when it is first called. All events will be in this order: 1st grade girls, 1st grade boys, 2<sup>nd</sup> grade girls, 2<sup>nd</sup> grade boys, 3rd grade girls, and 3rd grade boys. If a student's running or relay event is called while they are at the softball throw, they must tell the head of the softball throw that they need to go to their event. They will return to the softball throw when they are finished with their running/relay event.

## INTERMEDIATE TRACK MEET: IMPORTANT INFORMATION

INTERMEDIATE TRACK MEET-TUESDAY, MAY 23rd AT EVERETT MEMORIAL STADIUM FROM 8:45AM-2:00PM.

The meet begins at 9:00 sharp. Student carpools should leave the school by 7:45 to be at the stadium no later than 8:30. Enter the south parking lot and enter through the south gate. Holy Rosary School will be sitting in Section 2. Classroom teachers will be in charge of not allowing children into the upper/lower bleachers (lower if only a parent is there to supervise), and not leaving the premises. Please, no cell phones, headphones or iPods. You need to be able to hear your event being called.

No one is allowed onto the track except the volunteers and those students in the event. When the first call is made for an event the person in the events needs to immediately go down to the track area. No track shoes, spikes, or cleats will be allowed to be worn. Holy Rosary students are to wear blue Holy Rosary T-shirts. Although we want students to be competitive we also want everyone to be a good sport and cheer for all. If a student is in a field event and their running event is called they need to let the person in charge know they need to go to their event and will return later.

Please bring water bottles and sunscreen and also be prepared with raingear. There will be a concession stand at the field. If you plan on buying anything please bring small bills. The concession stand is being run by St. Thomas More this year. If you have any concerns please bring them to Sr. Kath or the other coaches. They will address your concerns. Do not bring your concerns to the volunteers.
