Religion - "God Made Music" Chapter 8. We discussed the beautiful sounds of music that we enjoy listening to around us. Such as our singing voices, instrumental music we play at rest time, music the children hear around their homes and our musical instruments we play during group time.

Literacy/Reading - Our HWT letters were B,R,K - the children learned the phonetic sounds and words that begin with those letters. The students are continuing to practice writing their names correctly using both upper and lower case letters. Our new "Word Wise" words are (cut, paste, curved, painted, triangle and shape).

Math - This week we practiced identifying how many unifix cubes make numbers 1-20. We played "Roll & Write" as a whole class - the children roll a dice and write the number of dots, the number or both of what they rolled on a ten frame mat.
