Dear Families,

As we approach Holy Thursday and Good Friday I want to make sure you are aware of our school's preparation for these two important days of Holy Week.

For Holy Thursday our 5th grade class taught by Mr. Flanagan will be hosting a special Seder meal of bread and grape juice for all of our students. The class will perform an abbreviated re-enactment of the Last Supper and lead the students in prayer. This will be held in our school lunchroom at 1:40.

This year Father Vincent is setting up a special visitation chapel in the Pastoral Center after the Holy Thursday evening celebration. The Eucharist will be present for veneration and continued prayer from approximately 8:30 PM-midnight on Thursday in preparation for Easter.

Our Good Friday service will be the Stations of the Cross, led by Mrs. Santucci's sixth grade class. This will begin at 10:00 and conclude at approximately 11:00. This year's Stations will have a little different venue: partly inside the church and partly outside. All parents and grandparents are welcome to attend. Students will return to their classrooms after the service and be dismissed for spring break at 12:00.

When we return to school after spring break we will have our Grandparents' & Special Friends' Day on April 27th. For this celebration all grandparents and special friends are invited to our school so that we can honor them at 9:00 mass and at a reception that morning.

It is amazing to see the academic, spiritual, and social growth of our students since the beginning of the year. We are so blessed to have such caring and dedicated teachers. On behalf of myself and our school staff I wish each of you a blessed and joyous Easter and an enjoyable spring break.

WHAT KIND OF GIFT CARDS?
