The 7th grade students presented Rube Goldberg machines on Thursday evening and all day Friday for Grandparents, Special Friends, and the entire Holy Rosary student population. Rube Goldberg was a cartoonist, engineer, and inventor throughout most of the 20th century. His cartoons showed multiple simple machines (levers, inclined planes, pulleys, wheels/axles, wedges, and screws) working together to complete a simple task. The 7th graders were asked to design and create a Rube Goldberg machine that would utilize several simple machines to launch a ping pong ball. Students worked through the entire design process from brainstorming, designing, drawing plans, and building the machine. One of the most important aspects gained from this project was the ability to problem solve when the machines at first did not succeed. The 7th grade students created amazing and fantastic machines that were shared with so many people over the course of those two days. A huge thank you goes to Mr. Montanari and all the 7th graders for providing these exceptional learning experiences at Holy Rosary School.

National Teacher Appreciation Day is Monday, May 7th when we will honor our outstanding teachers. We are truly fortunate to have teachers who are so caring and dedicated to helping our students be successful learners. 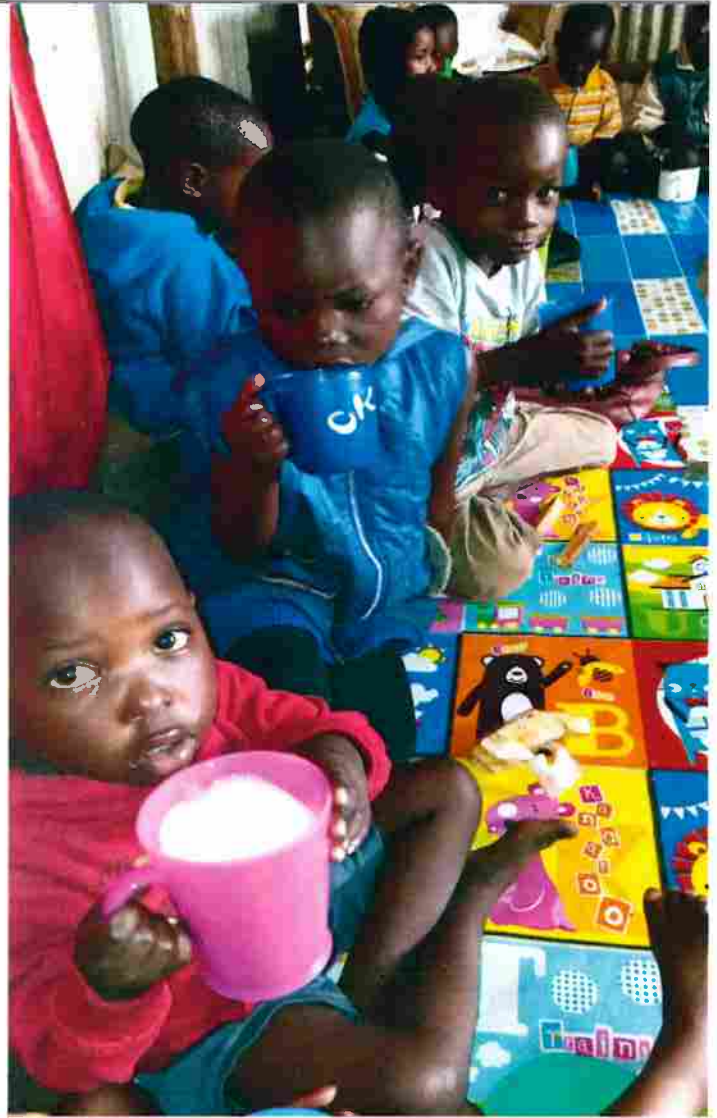
