HOLY ROSARY CYO CROSS-COUNTRY

For K-8th Graders

Come be a part of this great fall tradition. All K-8th graders are invited. Participating in cross-country is fun and great exercise. We hold two one hour weekly practices which are not mandatory, but extremely helpful and fun for the kids.

As coaches and parents, we recognize it is easy to overschedule kids. Our own kids are already signed up for other fall sports and activities. We want to provide kids with an easy way to get out in the woods for some fun, adventure and exercise. Cross country practices also provide an excellent way for kids to increase their speed, aerobic capacity, core strength and balance for other sports. We invite you to decide what your kids' participation in cross-country will be. If they aren't interested in racing, that's okay! One practice a week is fine too. We also encourage you to make cross-country a family activity. Parents are welcome to come walk in the woods, run with the kids, or play at the playground with smaller kids. Uniforms will be available for registered kids.

This is an extremely short season, so we hope that many of you can join us. K-2 graders run a 0.4 mile course; 3rd grade runs a .53 mile course, 4th/5th graders run a 1 mile course; 6th/7th graders run a 1.35 mile course, and 8th graders run a 1.47 mile course. Registration Due: August 1 *

Registration Fees: Grades K – 3 = \$90 Grades 4 – 8 = \$95

Coaches: Contact the undersigned by **June 1** if you are interested in coaching or assistant coaching

Games: Kindergarten: Sundays, September through October with a break in September for cross-country meets. Soccer games do not conflict with cross country meets.

Grades 1 – 8: Saturdays September through October

Grades 6 – 8 only, Playoffs: November Saturdays and Sundays

Games are played in the shoreline and greater Seattle area, and in Everett and north end areas. Playoff dates are announced at the end of the regular season.

Practices: Practices are held at Holy Rosary, or nearby. Practice time and location depends on the coaches' desired field and schedule. Priority scheduling is given to upper grades.

What if I don't know my fall schedule yet? Register your athlete if you have any interest in playing fall soccer. ***Teams fill up, and are made based on registrations received by August 1.** If your athlete is not registered by August 1, we cannot place them on a team. If you have signed up, but your fall schedule does not permit participating, contact the undersigned before August 20.

Who can play? : All youth in our Holy Rosary School and Parish community, grades K-8. Should a child wish to play that is not a member of our Holy Rosary community please contact the undersigned. Athletes will play for their own grade level, playing up will only be permitted in situations where there is no team for a particular grade level.

Rules / Divisions: Grades K-2 are Coed, Grades 3-8 are gender specific teams. CYO soccer follows FIFA rules, except as outlined in the CYO Athletics specific rules Please visit <http://www.oyyae.org/athletics/soccer/> for the rules that apply to your division

How do I find out if my athlete has a team/coach for their grade level: Contact the undersigned to determine your grade level's team status. We can only guarantee athletes are placed on a team if they are registered by August 1. We can tell you your team's status based on the number of inquiries and registrations we have received. If there are not enough athletes in a grade level to make a full roster we often combine with other grades and schools.
