## Attendance Procedures

To report an absence, late arrival or early pick-up the following procedure should be followed:

2. Include the reason for the absence, and the time to expect your child in the office for late arrival or early pickup.
3. If you do not contact the school, someone from the school office will contact you at work or home to verify your child's absence.
